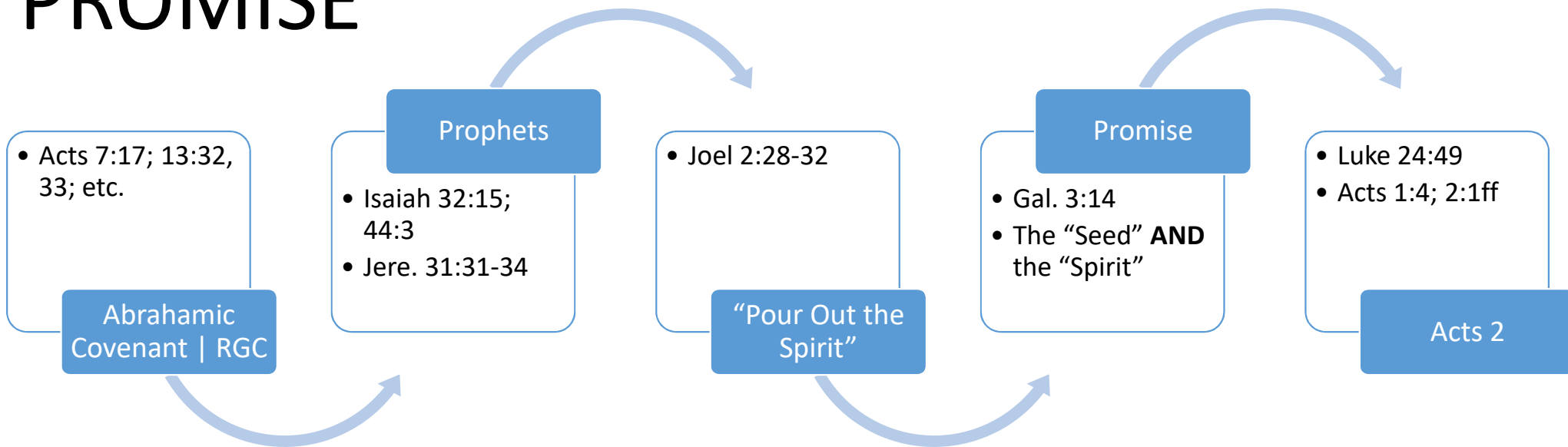


The HS in the ROYAL GIFT COVENANT as PROMISE



Q1 – We think of the Abrahamic Covenant as LAND, SEED, BLESSING, but is there more? Is the gifting of the Holy Spirit also included in the covenant?

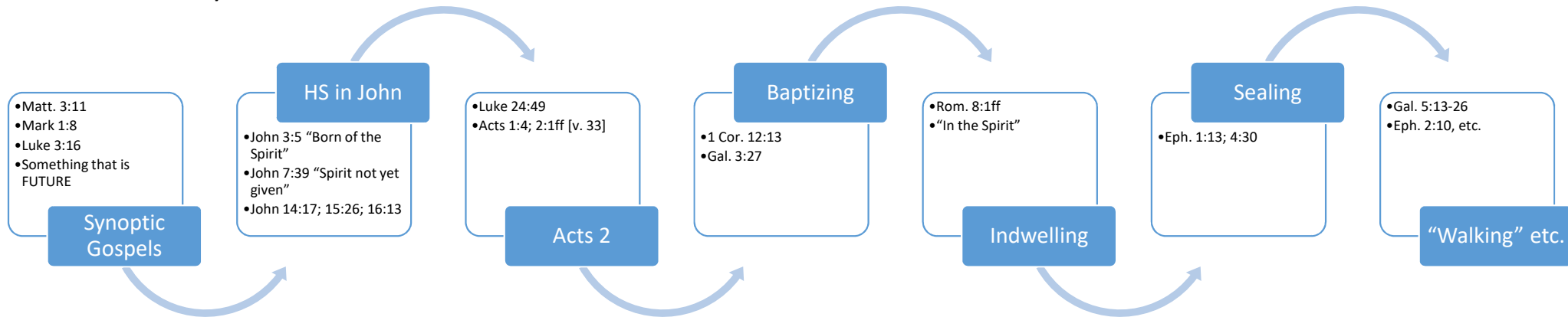
Q2 - As it relates to the working of the Holy Spirit, "Is there continuity between the Hebrew Scripture and the New Covenant?"

O1 – The Promise of a "Seed" and the Promise of the "Spirit" appear distinct, but inseparable Promises.

The HS in the New Covenant as Fulfillment of the ROYAL GIFT COVENANT

Q1 – Are the Synoptic Gospels picking up the ideas of the “Promise’ and the Prophets?

Q2 - What, if any, is the distinctiveness of the New Covenant to the Old Covenant?



O1 – The language of the Gospels speak of something that is future.

O2 – The Shekinah returning and the Baptizing of individual into the corporate “body” overlap but are different.

O3 – NT indwelling is intrinsic to the baptizing work of the HS. You cannot have one without the other.

O4 - It appears the distinctiveness of the Promise fulfilled in Jesus and the indwelling HS is that something external to them [Old Covenant] is now internal and in them [New Covenant].

O5 - The **means** for this fulfillment are the coming of the SEED PROMISE and consequential, but inseparable, the coming of the HOLY SPIRIT.
