BIG IDEA

- The Bible tells a **single** Story and at the **Center** of this Story is **Jesus**. This Story is traceable **from Genesis through Revelation**.

- Was Noah part of the Seed Story?
- Was Ruth part of the Seed Story?
- Does Isaiah the prophet speak to the Seed Promise and the Blood Picture?
- Were there many witnesses confirming the Story?
- Does the Word of God confirm the Story?
- Are we to be witnesses of the Story?
- Were His disciples told to wait?

Work through these Q with your parents when you go HOME 😊

- Does the Bible provide guidelines as to how we are to understand it?
- Does the Bible tell a single, unified Story with Jesus at the Center?
- Does the resurrection of Jesus confirm the Story?
- Does the Story continue “beyond” Jesus?
- Is the Biblical Story about the Seed Promise?

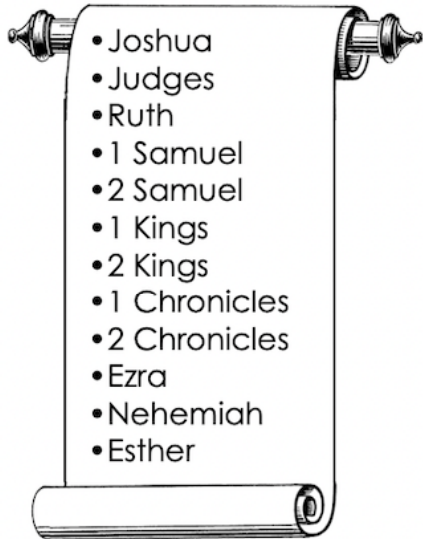

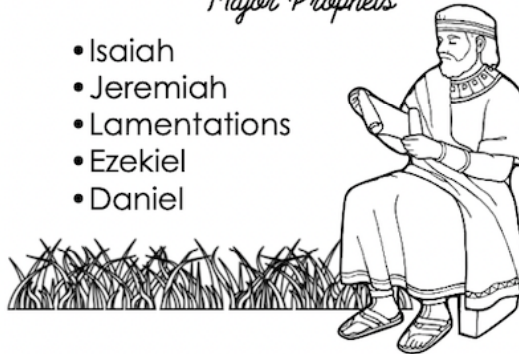
