Talk to your parents or Sunday School Teacher and have them explain what each of the three symbols to the left say and what they mean to you.

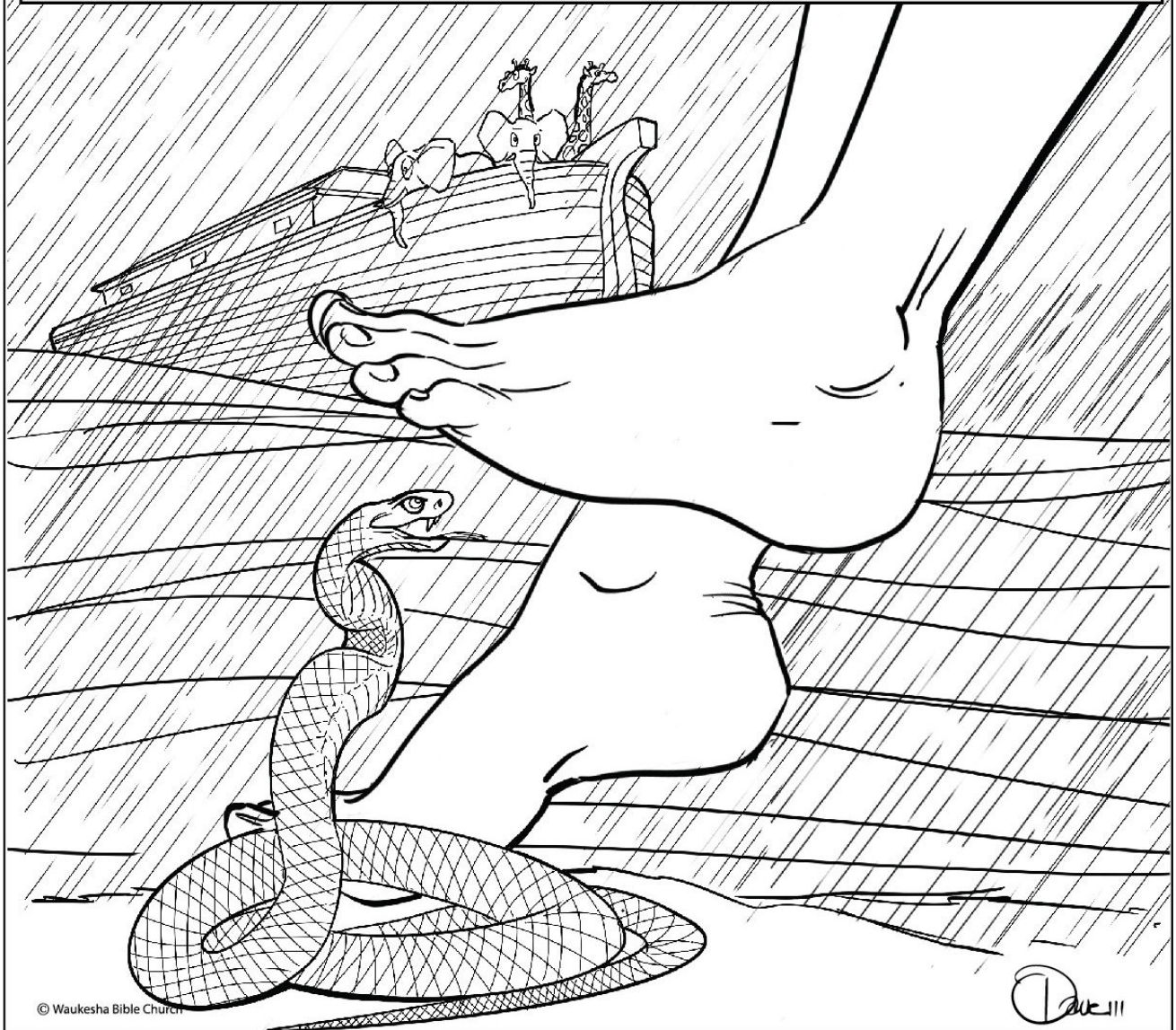
