“The Sacrifice of Isaac” – Genesis 22:1-14



Work through these Q with your parents when you go HOME 😊

- What did God ask of Abraham? (v. 2)
- Did God previously promise Abraham he would have many grandchildren by Isaac?
- If Abraham sacrificed Isaac, would God’s promise fail?
- Did Abraham obey God anyway? (v. 3)
- Did Abraham expect to return from the place of sacrifice with Isaac? (v. 5)
- Did Abraham have faith?
- Did God provide a substitute sacrifice for Isaac? (v. 13) What did He provide?
- As a result, did Isaac live?
- Did God supply a substitute sacrifice for our sins? (Gen. 3:21)
- Who was the substitute sacrifice? (Titus 2:13, 14)
- Do you have faith to believe Jesus is the sacrifice for your sins?

Talk to your parents or Sunday School Teacher and have them explain what each of the three symbols to the left say and what they mean to you.

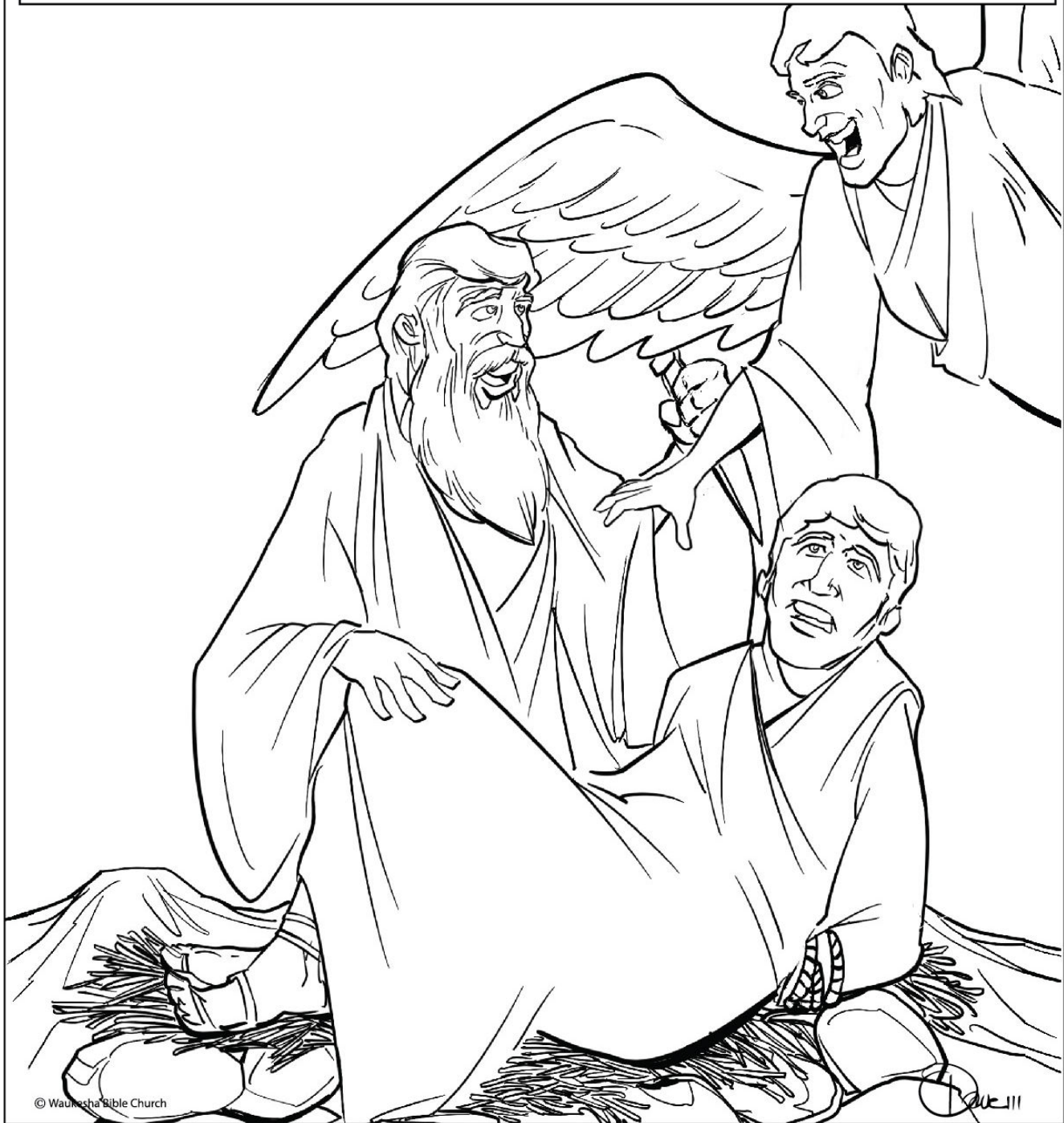
