Lesson	Passage Title	Main Passage	Bible Reading Schedule*	Main Point
1	Overview of Job	Job 38-40	Job	God is not answerable to Humanity for any of His actions
2a	Overview of Psalms	Psalms 1 and 2	Psalms	One can either choose to follow God [TORAH] or choose to reject God [TORAH]. There are eternal consequences to both choices.
2b	Psalms 1-2	Psalms 1 and 2	Psalms	Psalms 2 promises a Messiah that will make it possible for us to follow God. These two Psalms form an introduction to all of Psalms.
3a	Overview of Proverbs	Proverbs 1:1ff	Proverbs	God gave the Nation of Israel TORAH so that they would know how to live in an unbelieving world.
4	Overview of Ecclesiastes	Eccl. 12:13, 14	Ecclesiastes	Life in the horizontal appears vain, BUT GOD. God alone makes sense of this life.
