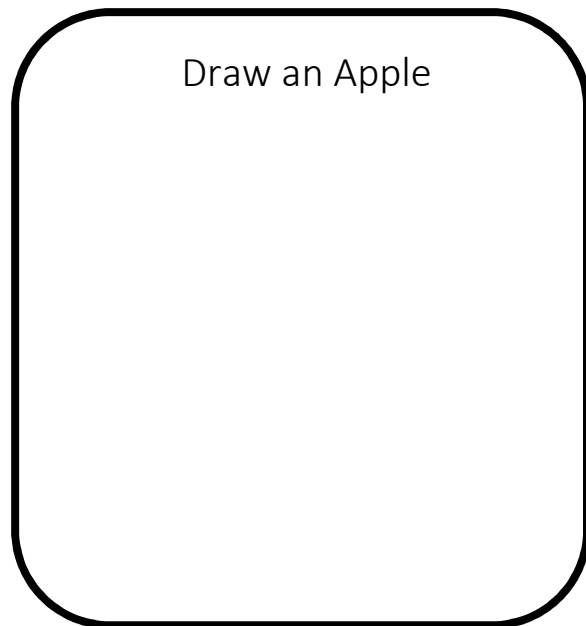

Bible Verses for Acts 2 - CREATION

1. **God** then **spoke** and from nothing came everything else into existence.
 - Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14, 20, 24, 26, 28, and 29 - “God Said” and when He does, everything obeys His will.
2. **God created** so that we might **know** and **experience** the **joy** He has within Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. And this **joy** is only **known** and **experienced** in His presence.
 - Psalm 16:11; 1 John 3:2 - The joy we are designed to know can only be known in His presence.
3. Everything created is **from** God, **sustained by** God and **for** God. Everything exists (including you and me) for His glory.
 - Romans 11:35; 1 Corinthians 8:6; Colossians 1:16-18 - There meaning no meaning to life if we do not see God as the author of life.
