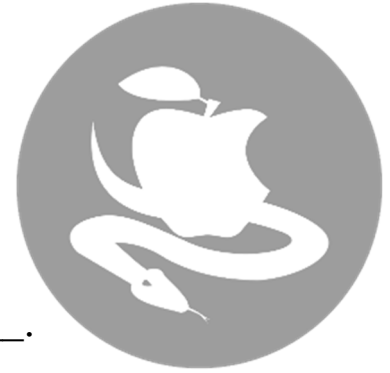

Bible Verses for Acts 3 - REJECTION

1. **God's creation of humanity** is unlike anything else created. **God invited** humanity to obey Him and follow His Word.
 - Genesis 1:26-28; 2:16, 17 – We are unique among God's creation in that we have choice. God desired for us to choose Him.
2. Adam and Eve **rejected** God's offer and **loved themselves** more than they **loved Him**.
 - Genesis 3:6 – Because they chose to disobey God, God removed them from His presence.
3. This was sin and caused Adam and Eve to **lose their joy** and **experience guilt and shame** for the very first time.
 - Genesis 3:10 – This began a series of horrible moments for Adam and Eve and their offspring.
