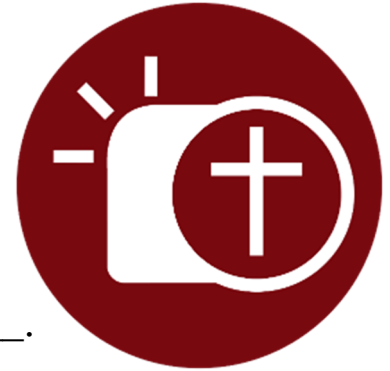

Bible Verses for Acts 4 - REDEMPTION

1. Because **humanity cannot save itself**, God intervened. He jumped in to help. He made a **Promise** of future deliverance (Gen. 3:15) and **Pictured** what this would look like by slaying an animal, **shedding its blood**, and clothing them in the robe of the innocent (Gen. 3:21).
 - Genesis 3:15, 21 – God made a promise and provided a picture of not just who, but how Adam and Eve would be restored into God’s presence.
2. All of this comes to pass in Jesus. He is **the fulfillment of the Seed Promise and the completion of the Blood Picture**.
 - Hebrews 7:27; 9:12, 26-28; 10:10 – Jesus Christ fulfills the promise and completes the picture. In Him and by Him, the Story is fulfilled and completed.
3. Jesus is the one and only who would **rescue us** from sin and **restore us** back to **joy**.
 - John 14:6; Acts 4:12; 1 Timothy 2:5 – Jesus Christ is God’s final answer from sin and death and for joy and glory.
