Bible Verses for Acts 5 - RE-CREATION

1. **In rescuing** Adam and Eve (and all those who call out to Him in faith and repentance), He **cancelled** their **sin** debt and **adopted** them into His **family**.
 - [cancel] Acts 3:19; Colossian 2:13, 14; Revelation 7:17; 21:4
 - [adopt] Romans 8:15; Galatians 4:5, 6
 - Jesus cancels sin and adopts sons.
2. Redemption re-creates His people into His image. Their standing before the Father becomes who JESUS is before the Father. The life flowing from this **identity** is His life. "Because as He is, so also are we in this world" (1 John 4:17; Cf. Col. 2:7).
3. This is called the "**new birth**" and a "**new heart**." God reverses the curse.
 - Ezekiel 36:26; John 3:3, 7; 1 Peter 1:23 - God does for us what we cannot do for ourselves. He makes us new!
4. He makes us into something **new**. Today, we live as **re-created people** in a heaven and earth that is **being re-created**.
 - Isaiah 65:17; 66:22; 2 Corinthians 5:17; 2 Peter 3:13 - God makes us new and will place us in a new heaven and earth where we will be with Him forever.
5. **Jesus** is right now **preparing this place** where we will be with Him for our joy forever. Praise the LORD.
 - John 14:1-6 - Jesus is re-creating this new Garden where His people will be with Him for their joy.
